4. Prague College reserves the right to edit, remove or delete any material deemed unacceptable under these guidelines and to limit or terminate service to participants who violate the terms of this agreement.

6. Participation in Moodle discussions occurs in real time. Prague College cannot and does not intend to screen messages in advance of their posting. However, if a message is posted that violates the policies listed here, Prague College may remove that message in its sole discretion at any time.
7. Your ID and password are unique and not to be lent or given to any other person.
8. Any information collected for the registration process is used solely by Prague College to create your account in the course management system. Required information is a valid email address. No information will ever be shared with a third party.
